

Administrative details and terms and conditions for the Grenoble Ecole de Management scholarships (updated 13 December 2022)

1. Value

A one-time Scholarship amount, will be offered to new students of the Grenoble Ecole de Management (GEM) Master's programs who meet the eligibility criteria listed in point 2 below.

1.1 Early Admission Scholarship - SGD1500.00

1.2 SIM Alumni Scholarship - SGD2500.00

The scholarship amount will be used to offset the recipient's course fees for the Master's programs offered at SIM.

2. Eligibility Criteria

The recipient must be a new applicant for the GEM Master's programme to be eligible for the scholarship.

Applicants will be eligible for one GEM scholarship at anyone time.

2.1 Early Admission Scholarship

The recipient must have completed the application process and paid an application fee in the GEM application system to be considered for the scholarship.

2.2 SIM Alumni Scholarship

The recipient must have successfully completed and graduated from a SIM University Partner's programme before 31 March 2023 and have completed the application process and paid an application fee in the GEM application system to be considered for the scholarship 2023.

2.3 Conditions under which the scholarship will not be offered

- a) If your application has been rejected.
- b) If you have withdrawn your application at any point prior to course commencement.
- c) If you withdraw from the programme at any point upon class commencement.

2.4 Students may reject the scholarship offer in writing.

3. Course Fee payment

Subject to eligibility, the scholarship value of SGD1500 (Early Admission Scholarship) and SGD2500 (SIM Alumni Scholarship) will be reimbursed to your Singapore bank account or an overseas account with bank charges borne by recipient before the start of Year 2 Semester 2. You will need to make full payment of your first three semesters' fees before receiving this rebate. The scholarship will otherwise be withdrawn or revoked.

4. Terms and conditions upon receiving the scholarship.

The scholarship is tenable for the minimum period required to complete the full course of study, as stipulated by the programme. There is no bond to the scholarship.

Recipients must adhere to these conditions.

- a) Sit for all tests, assessments and examinations. GEM and SIM might revoke the scholarship and recipients will be subjected to refund the amount awarded if recipients do not demonstrate due diligence in their studies.
- b) Contribute actively to the SIM-GEM community such as sharing of learning journey at briefings and fairs.

5. Suspension or Termination

SIM-GEM have the authority to suspend or terminate and may at its joint discretion vary the terms and conditions, or amend or issue additional guidelines with respect to the Scholarship, with due notice given. All such guidelines shall be deemed to be part of the terms and conditions of the Scholarship.

6. How to Apply

The Master's scholarship application opens now for post-graduate courses commencing in 2023. You will be considered for the scholarship as long as you have submitted all completed documents to the GEM Full Fabric application system and paid the GEM application fee by the application fee by the stipulated deadline stated in point 2.1 or 2.2.
