

Administrative details and terms and conditions for the University of Birmingham scholarships (Updated 12 November 2024)

1. Value

A one-time amount of SGD5000 will be offered to new students at the University of Birmingham (UoB) master's programs who meet the scholarship requirements and has successfully been offered a place of study at SIM.

2. Eligibility Criteria

2.1 To qualify for the scholarship, the recipient will need to have the following academic criteria and meet the English Language requirements listed in the respective programme web page.

Programme	Academic criteria
Master of Science Financial Management	Bachelor's degree in any discipline (First Class or Upper Second-Class Honours degree) or an equivalent qualification
Master of Science International Business	

2.2 The recipient must be a new applicant for the UoB Master's programme to be eligible for the scholarship.

2.3 The recipient must have completed the application process and paid an application fee via the SIM online application system by the cut-off date, as listed below, to be considered for the scholarship.

2.4 Conditions under which the scholarship would not be offered.

- a) If the applicant has been rejected by the university.
- b) If the applicant has withdrawn from the programme prior to course commencement.
- c) If the student has withdrawn from the programme at any point upon class commencement.

2.5 Recipients may reject the scholarship offer in writing to SIM.

3. Course Fee payment

Subject to eligibility, SIM would reimburse the scholarship amount to the recipient's Singapore bank account or an overseas account, with bank charges borne by the recipient, after full programme fees have been paid. The student must make full payment based on the invoice amount to SIM by the payment due date before receiving the reimbursement amount. Otherwise, SIM will withdraw or revoke the scholarship.

4. Terms and conditions upon receiving the scholarship.

The scholarship is tenable for the minimum period required to complete the full course of study, as stipulated by the programme. There is no bond to the scholarship.

Scholarship recipients must adhere to these conditions.

- a) Sit for all tests and examinations and participate in all assessments. UoB and SIM may revoke the scholarship and have recipients refund the amount awarded if they do not demonstrate due diligence in their studies.
- b) Contribute actively to the UoB-SIM community such as sharing of learning journey at briefings and fairs.

5. Suspension or Termination

UoB-SIM have the authority to suspend or terminate and may at its joint discretion vary the terms and conditions or amend or issue additional guidelines with respect to the Scholarship, with due notice given. All such guidelines shall deem to be part of the terms and conditions of the Scholarship.

6. How to Apply

The master's scholarship application opens in October 2024 and is applicable to the University of Birmingham Master of Science courses commencing from October 2025. You would be considered for the scholarship if you have submitted all completed documents and paid in full the application fee by the stipulated deadline stated in point 2.3.
