

Administrative details and terms and conditions for the University of Birmingham scholarships
(updated 06 September 2022)

1. Value

A one-time amount of SGD1000 will be offered to new students of the University of Birmingham (UoB) Master's programs who meet the scholarship requirements and has successfully been offered a place of study at SIM. The scholarship amount will be used to offset the recipient's course fees and materials for the duration of the Master's programs.

2. Eligibility Criteria

2.1 To qualify for the scholarship the recipient will need to have the following academic criteria as well as to meet the English Language requirements listed in the respective programme web page.

Programme	Academic criteria
Master of Business Administration	Bachelor's degree in a relevant Business/ Management discipline (UK Upper 2nd Class Honours degree or equivalent)
Master of Science Financial Management	Bachelor's degree (UK Upper 2nd Class Honours or equivalent)
Master of Science International Business	Bachelor's degree (UK Upper 2nd Class Honours or equivalent)
Master of Science Management	Bachelor's degree in a relevant business, management or economics (UK Upper 2nd Class Honours degree or equivalent)

2.2 The recipient must be a new applicant for the UoB Master's programme to be eligible for the scholarship.

2.3 The recipient must have completed the application process and paid an application fee via the SIM online application system by the cut-off date in order to be considered for the scholarship.

2.4 Conditions under which the scholarship will not be offered.

- a) If your application has been rejected.
- b) If you have withdrawn your application at any point prior to course commencement.
- c) If you withdraw from the programme at any point upon class commencement.

2.5 Students may reject the scholarship offer in writing.

3. Course Fee payment

The SGD 1000 scholarship will be reflected as a rebate in your first course fee payment invoice. You will need to make full payment based on the invoice amount by the payment due date. The scholarship will otherwise be withdrawn or revoked.

4. Terms and conditions upon receiving the scholarship.

The scholarship is tenable for the minimum period required to complete the full course of study, as stipulated by the programme. There is no bond to the scholarships.

Recipients must adhere to these conditions.

- a) Sit for all tests, assessments and examinations. UoB and SIM might revoke the scholarship and have recipients pay back the amount of SGD1000 if recipients do not demonstrate due diligence in their studies.
- b) Contribute actively to the UoB-SIM community such as sharing of learning journey at briefings and fairs.

5. Suspension or Termination

UoB-SIM have the authority to suspend or terminate and may at its joint discretion vary the terms and conditions, or amend or issue additional guidelines with respect to the Scholarship, with due notice given. All such guidelines shall be deemed to be part of the terms and conditions of the Scholarship.

6. How to Apply

The Master's scholarship application opens in September 2022 and is applicable for post-graduate courses commencing from January 2023. You will be considered for the scholarship as long as you have submitted all completed documents and paid in full the application fee by the stipulated deadline stated in point 2.3.
