THE LADY HAILSHAM STAFF



The Lady Hailsham Staff was presented to the University in February 1982 by the Sir Robert Menzies Oration Committee. It is a memorial to Lady Hailsham, who died tragically in a horse-riding accident two days before her husband was to deliver the University's Inaugural Oration in May 1978.

The staff was designed by Mr David Connolly, an alumnus of the University and a member of the Australian Parliament, and crafted by V Hemmingsen of Adelaide and P Noakes of Sydney. It has a shaft of Tasmanian blackwood with the tip and joins in silver. Surmounting the staff is a viscountess's coronet (a mark of Lady Hailsham's position in British society) on top of a silver thistle and a ball of marble.

The marble comes from Connemara in the west of Ireland, the district from which Lady Hailsham's family originated. The coronet is studded with sapphires from Sri Lanka, where she spent part of her childhood.

The thistle symbolises the association with Sir Robert Menzies, Australia's longest serving prime minister, who was invested in 1963 as Australia's only Knight of the Order of the Thistle.

The staff is carried in procession by the Yeoman Bedell.
