The University at Buffalo has a distinguished 179-year history of academic leadership, scholarly excellence, outstanding teaching, and engaged public service. Founded as a private medical school in 1846, the University of Buffalo formally merged with the State University of New York system in 1962. Today, UB is the largest and most comprehensive public university in New York State and New England, and is recognized nationally and internationally as a preeminent, influential, and innovative institution of higher learning.

A member of the prestigious Association of American Universities (AAU), UB is enriched by a distinguished faculty and dedicated professional staff, state-ofthe-art academic resources and facilities, and a large, diverse, and academically accomplished student body whose members come from nearly every state in the nation and from around the world. UB's more than 32,000 students pursue their academic interests through more than 300 undergraduate, graduate, and professional degree programs. UB is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and numerous professional accrediting associations.

A leading center of international education, UB enrolls more than 5,000 students from more than 100 countries. UB maintains exchange programs with more than 90 leading institutions in more than 30 countries around the world, and conducts overseas academic programs in India, Japan, Singapore and Taiwan. The university has active Alumni Association chapters in Canada, China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, Turkey and United Arab Emirates.

UB's outstanding faculty are engaged in a diverse array of research institutes, centers, and laboratories, several of which are collaborative efforts with the university's academic research partners. The university's research centers and faculty initiatives annually account for more than \$439 million in new grants from federal and state agencies, foundations, and industrial research partners. As a research-intensive university, and a major community cultural resource for the creative and performing arts, UB has an educational impact that is profound in both depth and scope, extending well beyond the region, state, and nation.

Integrally connected to UB's mission of academic excellence is the university's public mission of outreach, service, and community engagement both locally and globally. Through its strength, leadership, and excellence in research, scholarship and education, UB is committed to enriching the communities it serves throughout Western New York, New York State, the U.S., and the world.

College of Arts and Sciences

Established in 1915, the College of Arts and Sciences is the largest and most diverse academic unit at the University at Buffalo. Organized around 30 academic departments and 16 programs, the College of Arts and Sciences enrolls some 7,600 undergraduate students, and more than 1,400 graduate students. Departments range from Anthropology to Visual Studies, and from Biological Sciences to Theatre and Dance. Today the College provides approximately 80 percent of freshman instruction on the UB campus, and over 60% of all undergraduate instruction campus-wide. At UB's campuses in Buffalo the College has approximately 420 full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty, and about 90 post-doctoral research fellows. The College is also home to internationally renowned research centers and programs, including the Institute for Lasers, Photonics and Biophotonics; the National Center for Geographic Information and Analysis; and the Center of Excellence on Human Capital, Technology Transfer, & Economic Growth and Development.

Department of Communication

The study of communication embraces the most fundamental aspects of human interaction – from the subtleties of interpersonal communication, to the cutting edge of the new communication technologies and information studies. With an emerging global economy and telecommunication as well as networking technology helping to drive this economy, the need within industry, government, and education for individuals who know how to connect people with information using appropriate technical and social mechanisms is dramatically increasing. The Communication Department is educating the next

generation of information professionals, knowledge workers and communication and information researchers. The shared principle that information serves the purposes of human communication and is enhanced by technological systems is at the core of our curriculum. The Department is devoted to the scientific study of communication phenomena. Its major areas of research include social influence, health communication, new communication technology, and the analysis of social networks. In addition, the Department conducts research in the traditional areas of interpersonal, organizational, mass, and international/ intercultural communication.

Department of Economics

The Department of Economics is dedicated to providing students with the basic knowledge required to understand how economic problems are approached, and imparting the basic gualitative and guantitative tools used by economists to solve economic problems. The Department contributes to these goals by serving the needs of our undergraduate and graduate students, by engaging in cutting edge research, and by continuously improving the design of our academic programs, our curriculums and our course offerings. Students majoring in economics will learn and apply the methods of economics in depth. They will become familiar with the discipline, the role economics plays in relation to other areas of study, and the impact economics has on decisions and policymaking. The demand for economists has increased steadily over the past decades. There are several reasons for this. Foremost is the transition over the past forty years of economics into an applied science, a change made possible by powerful computers, advanced mathematical and statistical software, and the collection of detailed datasets by government agencies such as the Bureau of Labor Statistics, research organizations such as the National Bureau of Economic Research, and universities such as UB.

Department of Geography

The Department of Geography, which offers the International Trade and Geographic Information Science degree programs, offers specializations in Environmental and Earth Systems Science; Geographic Information Science; Health and Human Geography; International Trade, International Business, and Economic/Human Geography; and Urban and Regional Analysis. Geography is primarily concerned with the location and arrangement in space of human and natural phenomena, and with the interrelationships between people and their environments. Geographers have an intense curiosity about the world. They ask questions and investigate the "why" and "where" of various social, economic and environmental phenomena. They contribute to the development of public policy and influence the way society views itself and the world. Geographers are interested in such topics as the location of industry and business, urban growth

and development, regional planning and policy, physical and ecological environments, interactions of people and places over space and time, and the diffusion of information and innovation.

Department of Psychology

Established in 1919, the Department of Psychology has a long tradition of excellence in research and teaching. The Department's mission is devoted to both the scientific study of mind and behavior as well as the training of future scientists at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The Department has four major research and training foci: Behavioral Neuroscience, Clinical, Cognitive, and Social. The department's undergraduate program is the largest in the College of Arts and Sciences, providing a broad and intensive major in psychology as a life science - encompassing the areas of Behavioral Neuroscience and Cognitive Psychology – and psychology as a social science - encompassing the areas of Clinical and Social Psychology. Undergraduate majors in the Department are exposed to the core content areas in modem scientific psychology and are trained in state-of-the-art experimental methods and data analyses. The graduate program, also organized around the four research areas, is well known for rigorous training programs in research and teaching that prepare doctoral and masters students for successful careers in scientific psychology. Faculty in the Department are actively engaged in a wide variety of research endeavors, ranging from work on the neural and endocrine bases of maternal behavior to speech and music perception to close relationships. In addition, the faculty maintain multiple individual laboratories consisting of specialized research facilities. Both undergraduate and graduate students are vital to the day-to-day functioning of the clinical and laboratory facilities and take active roles in the ongoing research efforts of the department's internationally recognized faculty.

Department of Sociology

Since 1924 undergraduate students from across New York State and beyond have come to the University at Buffalo in pursuit of a degree in sociology. Beginning in the 1940's the UB sociology department began offering graduate degrees at both the MA and PhD levels. Through their investigations in sociology, students have explored pressing questions related to contemporary social life, the processes of social change, and the social causes and consequences of human behavior. Our distinguished faculty have received national and international recognition for their scholarship; have published their research with top publishers, have been awarded research grants from prestigious public and private organizations; and have won prizes for excellence in the classroom. The department provides a solid foundation in sociological theory and research methods and concentrates in the substantive areas of

Family and the Life Course, Law and Society, Race and Ethnicity, and Urban and Community. Undergraduate majors are exposed to the study of the causes, characteristics, changes, and consequences of human behavior in groups and the structure and dynamics of social systems and issues. The program emphasizes the study of individuals, social groups, and social systems as they relate to each other and to important societal issues, such as community, education, family, gender, social class, culture, law, health, environment, and war.

School of Management

Since its inception in 1923, the School of Management has built an impressive reputation as one of the best schools of business in the world. The comprehensive range of its academic portfolio, the expertise of its faculty and the worldwide success of its graduates are the primary reasons for the school's acclaim.

The School of Management currently has an enrollment of more than 4,000 undergraduate, MBA, master's and doctoral students at campuses in Buffalo, Singapore and India. Approximately 1,000 participants attend business training programs each year at the School's Center for Executive Development. Its network of 46,000 alumni includes business people in leadership positions all over the world.

All academic programs offered by the School of Management are accredited by the prestigious AACSB International, and the School's MBA, undergraduate and doctoral programs have been ranked as among the best in the nation by The Wall Street Journal, U.S. News & World Report and the Gourman Report.

Domestically, the school offers a full-time MBA program, an Executive MBA program and a Professional (part-time) MBA program, several master's programs as well as an undergraduate business administration program and a doctoral business program. The faculty of the School of Management includes scholars renowned in their fields, eight of whom have received the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching.

The School of Management is recognized worldwide for innovation in international management education. Its programs help meet the University's goal of developing business leaders who can manage people and resources in a global marketplace.

In 1984, UB was selected to design and implement the first MBA program jointly sponsored by the governments of the U.S. and the People's Republic of

China. More than 200 Chinese managers earned this MBA degree and are now in upper-level executive positions throughout Chinese enterprises and government. As alumni, they continue to interact with the school today. Governments of economically emerging countries, such as Hungary, Latvia and Indonesia, have also recognized and called upon UB's expertise and experience in international management.

In 1999, the School of Management launched a new Executive MBA program in collaboration with the School of Business of Renmin University in Beijing, one of China's top ranked business schools. Participants in the China Executive MBA program included senior managers from major U.S. and European multinational firms and leading Chinese enterprises.

Multinational corporations (MNCs) frequently engage faculty from UB to design and teach their overseas training programs. In 1999, the school was selected by Motorola University to establish a new Executive MBA for the China telecommunications sector.

Since 2007, the School of Management has partnered with Amrita University in the delivery of a Master's Degree in Business Analytics and Systems in Bangalore, India.

The University at Buffalo Seal



Description

The official university seal is a circular plaque, with "University at Buffalo" and "The State University of New York" surrounding an inner plaque. On the inner plaque is a bison, signifying the university's local origin, mounted on an escutcheon that is supported by the palm leaves of victory. The escutcheon itself contains two inescutcheons, bearing the initials U and B, and 1846, the year of the university's founding. A chevron separating the inescutcheons is charged with the flames of wisdom.

History

Before 1922, the university's official seal represented only the medical, dental, and law schools. In 1922 the University Council commissioned Lucius Bartlett to design a new seal that would represent the entire university. This seal, cut by Tiffany and Company and officially adopted by the university on September 18, 1923, featured the university's name in Latin. The official university seal adopted in 1982 showed the university's name in English. The seal was revised slightly in 2001 to feature our formal University at Buffalo, The State University of New York name in the outer ring.

Alumni Association

The UB Alumni Association is an organization dedicated to reaching, serving and engaging alumni in the life of the university. In conjunction with the Office of Alumni Engagement, the Alumni Association provides a myriad of programs, services and benefits to UB's 280,000 alumni worldwide. In addition to alumni chapters in the USA, there are also UB alumni chapters in Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, China, India and 7 other locations.

The University at Buffalo Alumni Association is a volunteer-led international organization whose mission is to provide ongoing service to alumni and focus alumni support for, and service to, UB, its students, faculty, and staff.

Our vision is to work toward a future where UB students and alumni take pride in their UB experience and pass that enthusiasm on to their children, prospective students and others. The association has a stability of purpose and function, and fosters cooperative support for the university among all campus alumni groups, so that the synergy of our combined efforts assures UB of unfailing alumni support and the means by which to take its place among America's great public universities. In the future, alumni from all over the world are prominent stakeholders, participating in key decisions at the very top levels of the university.
