**RMIT Council proudly awards Michaela Browning with the Doctor of Business *honoris causa*.**

Michaela Browning has made a profound impact in her field and to our regional community more broadly, through an expansive career spanning both the public and private sectors.

Michaela is currently Partner and CEO Asia Pacific for global advisory firm Brunswick Group, and serves on a number of commercial, business and not-for-profit boards across the region. She was previously Vice President and Regional Head of Government and Public Policy for Asia Pacific at Google, and served on

the Regional Operations Committee, Global Affairs and Risk Committees. She is also a Non Executive Director of Optus, Singtel Board, Australia's second largest telecommunications firm. Prior to her corporate career, she spent more than two decades in the Australian government, focused on diplomacy, trade, and security in Asia.

Michaela served as Australia's Consul General to Hong Kong and Macau; inaugural CEO of the National Foundation of Australia China relations; Senior Advisor to ministers for Defence and Foreign Affairs; and as a senior trade negotiator and head of global investment for Australia. She is currently a Prime Minister-appointed Australian representative to the APEC Business Advisory Council where she chairs the Finance and Economics Working Group and leads efforts on AI, quantum and digital transformation.

Her leadership extends beyond government and corporate fields, where Michaela has been actively involved in numerous professional and advisory boards that reflect her commitment to fostering dialogue and regional relationships. She sits on the board of the US-ASEAN Business Council, the Australia Japan Business Co-Operation Committee, and Asia Society Australia. She has served on the Asian Development Bank Digital Advisory Committee.

# INTRODUCTION

## **BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE (AVIATION)**

The Bachelor of Applied Science (Aviation) program equips graduates with strong analytical skills and a deep understanding of the aviation operating environment. Through the program, students develop critical thinking abilities and problem-solving expertise tailored to the aviation industry.

As global travel demand continues to grow in the post-pandemic era, the need for skilled aviation professionals has never been greater. This program prepares graduates to play a vital role in shaping the future of aviation, ensuring they are well-positioned to meet industry demands. RMIT graduates remain highly sought after, recognized for their strong capabilities and employability worldwide.

## **BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE (CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT) (HONOURS)**

The Bachelor of Applied Science (Construction Management) (Honours) is a two-and-a-half-year part-time program. The program comprises of 12 modules (including a research project) undertaken over 5 semesters. The program is designed to offer those holding a diploma in building or a related discipline the opportunity to upgrade their knowledge and skills to a bachelor degree. The program is offered on an advanced standing status to students with the relevant academic and professional achievements.

## **BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (ACCOUNTANCY)**

The Bachelor of Business (Accountancy) is a fully accredited Australian undergraduate degree with international professional accountancy bodies. Upon successful completion of the programme, students are eligible for Associate membership with Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (CAANZ) and CPA Australia and other professional accounting bodies.

As a graduate of the Bachelor of Business (Accountancy), you will obtain many transferable skills. These skills will enable you to analyse and evaluate information to complete a range of activities relating to the accounting discipline. The learning of skills in the Bachelor of Accounting curriculum is achieved through both skills embedded in curriculum design, and through an integrated capabilities framework.

First launched in Singapore in 1993, the BP254 Bachelor of Business (Accountancy) programme ran successfully for 30 years, concluding in Semester 2, 2023—a testament to its enduring quality and academic rigour. While the programme has since been updated to the BP351 Bachelor of Accounting to reflect evolving industry needs, the BP254 degree remains fully recognised and respected by employers and professional bodies alike.

## **BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (ECONOMICS AND FINANCE)**

The Bachelor of Business (Economics and Finance) degree is a unique, well-established, and recognised programme that offers two specialisations - economics and finance - opening doors to diverse industries and abundant employment opportunities. Our graduates are equipped with the skills and knowledge necessary to analyse economic trends, make informed financial decisions, and take advantage of the interplay between the two disciplines in their working environment. This dual focus enhances critical thinking, analytical, and problem-solving abilities, making our students highly sought-after by a wide range of employers across various industries and numerous occupation pathways. Courses are designed in conjunction with leading finance and economic industry partners through an industry advisory board of high-profile executives. The applied learnings therefore provide our graduates with the confidence to lead and succeed in an ever-changing economic environment.

## **BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS)**

The Bachelor of Business (International Business) programme has been introduced in July 2019 in Singapore. The programme enables students to develop an understanding of conducting business across national borders. It will address topics including international trade, international

financial markets, global logistics and supply chain management, and cross-cultural management. Students will also study courses like global corporate responsibility which informs how to manage businesses responsibly in the international and global context. The interplay between world's political economy and international business including multinational corporations are explored in the programme as well.

The international business major aims to equip students with the essential knowledge and skills to work in international business and begin their career with a much-needed global mindset.

## **BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (MANAGEMENT)**

The Bachelor of Business (Management) programme is offered on a full-time as well as part-time basis.

The Management programme has been offered in Singapore since 1988 and has been one of RMIT's most popular programmes both in Melbourne and throughout the Asia-Pacific region. The programme offered in Singapore combines the best of local expertise with RMIT's academic expertise.

Students will learn how to deal with complex issues, lead teams and make business decisions applicable across a variety of organisational structures. The Management programme will challenge students to consider the local

impact of global changes to markets and business practices. The degree offers graduates an excellent basis for both supervisor and management practice in a range of professional, commercial, industrial and not-for-profit organisations.

## BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (MARKETING)

The Bachelor of Business (Marketing) degree focusses on developing skills, knowledge and practices through industry-focused projects that help our students develop the tools to succeed as a marketing professional.

The Marketing programme at RMIT has been designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills needed to become an innovative and socially aware marketing professional who can engage industry and society with forward-thinking marketing solutions to the problems of the future. Our graduates have researched markets and customers, explored buyer behaviour, understood sales strategy and communication skills, built cutting edge strategies, and applied a variety of specialist marketing approaches, including retailing, brand development, product innovation and digital marketing, through a range of industry-relevant courses.

RMIT Marketing graduates are prepared for an international career in marketing through its blended delivery options, industry collaboration opportunities, showcasing of contemporary marketing theories and a focus on

customer understanding and insight development.

The Bachelor of Business (Marketing) full-time degree first commenced in Singapore in 2005. This degree is accredited by the Australian Marketing Institute.

## BACHELOR OF BUSINESS (LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT)

The Bachelor of Business (Logistics and Supply Chain Management) programme prepares students to tackle business problems in the global marketplace and understand the complex world of logistics, supply chain and trade industries. Students cover areas that include procurement and global sourcing, operations management, warehousing and distribution channels, transportation and freight logistics, transport economic, retail and service logistics, supply chain technologies, supply chain analytics, and strategic supply chain.

This degree is accredited by the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport Australia (CILTA). Another important industry association supporting the programme is The Logistics and Supply Chain Management Society Singapore (LSCMS).

## THE NEW BACHELOR OF BUSINESS

The New Bachelor of Business programme provides students with broad and coherent theoretical and technical business knowledge to enter

professional work and/or undertake further learning. Students have a choice of majors, minors and options. The Bachelor of Business also gives students the option to engage in cross disciplinary knowledge. This approach allows students to gain new perspectives and recognises the diversity of business professions in the future.

The new Bachelor of Business programme is designed to equip students with the skills and confidence to succeed in a rapidly changing business landscape. The programme offers flexible learning options with a variety of majors, minors and elective courses/units allowing students to tailor their education to their career aspirations. The Bachelor of Business emphasises hands-on learning through real-world projects and internships, fostering critical thinking, problem-solving, and interpersonal skills. The course benefits from strong industry connections, including partnerships with companies like L'Oréal and the Singapore Red Cross. This programme was launched in Singapore in 2023. The programme has two intakes a year.

## **BACHELOR OF COMMUNICATION (PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATION)**

The Bachelor of Communication (Professional Communication) is a communication degree incorporating specialist study in Advertising and Public Relations. The interdisciplinary nature of the degree reflects the workplace reality of increasing integration of these professions. It

encourages creative and critical thinking, and offers diversity in approaches to teaching and learning. The program's capstone course will consolidate and extend your knowledge through individual and collaborative projects. Upon completion you will have a broad knowledge of the media and communication industries and be able to analyse issues, communicate informed ideas and apply independent judgement to problems within a global communication context.

## **BACHELOR OF DESIGN (COMMUNICATION DESIGN)**

The Bachelor of Design (Communication Design) programme commenced in Singapore in 2002. RMIT University has a reputation as a centre of excellence for teaching and research in design. Students develop expertise in visual language and strategic design processes based on a thorough knowledge of conceptual and visual design principles. These aptitudes are combined with students' individual design aesthetics and understanding of the technologies and media for production. As a culmination of the programme, a graduation exhibition is held to showcase the students' design work. This is an important milestone for the graduating students as the process of preparing for the exhibition enhances their skills in organising a successful event comparable to that of the corporate world. It is also a good opportunity to showcase students' talent and creativity.
