






# SIM – UNIVERSITY OF STIRLING GRADUATION CEREMONY

The University of Stirling's Coat of Arms dates back to November 1966 and, following an application to Lord Lyon, the University gained its University status by Royal Charter on 27 December 1967.

The Coat of Arms may be described as an arched bridge topped by a tower and surrounded by open books. The bridge may represent a governor or magistrate, the tower safety and guardianship, while the open books have clear associations with learning and knowledge. The imagery portrays the University as an official guardian entrusted with the safekeeping of the process of imparting knowledge, while serving the wider community.

On a visual level, the three elements of the Coat of Arms may be interpreted as a reflection of the University's striking location in a historic Scotland, evoking Stirling Bridge, the National Wallace Monument and the University itself.

#### Early life and career beginnings

Datuk Andrew Lim, a Malaysian entrepreneur, was born and raised in Penang. Datuk Lim is a barristerat-law (Middle Temple) and he received his Bachelor of Laws degree (LLB Hons) from University College Cardiff, Wales, UK. He embarked on his legal career by practising in his late father's legal firm namely M/s Lim Cheng Poh & Partners. It was while practising law that he developed a keen interest in the retail industry, with his involvement as a board member in GAMA, a local department store and supermarket in Penang, popular for its array of imported goods from China. Datuk Lim then ventured into the retail business by buying into the GAMA Group of Companies in 2000, and subsequently, he also acquired the SOGO Seibu Group of Companies in 2002. His extensive legal background proved invaluable to him during his transition from legal practice into the retail industry.

#### **Turning around SOGO Kuala Lumpur**

In 2002, Datuk Lim spearheaded the management buyout of SOGO Kuala Lumpur. Under his leadership, SOGO was successfully revitalised into a profitable and thriving retail business, solidifying its presence as a key department store and supermarket player in Malaysia's retail landscape. Since then his Sogo Seibu Group has grown into a chain of five large format stores throughout Malaysia.

### **HONORARY DEGREE**

#### Strategic acquisitions and retail expansion

Datuk Andrew Lim then expanded his retail interests by setting up Macrovalue Sdn Bhd together with his old friend Datuk Gary Yap Keng Fatt in 2022. In 2023, Macrovalue acquired multiple well-known supermarket brands in Malaysia, including:

- Cold Storage
- · Mercato
- · TMC (Teng Mini Mart)
- Giant
- · Giant Mini
- Uncle Jack's

This acquisition of GCH Retail Malaysia strengthened his group's position in the retail sector, reinforcing their ability to grow their retail businesses with strong brand recognition.

#### **Expertise in diverse retail formats**

Datuk Lim's Groups of Companies have demonstrated remarkable adaptability in navigating various retail formats, from high-end outlets like SEIBU & SOGO to mainstream market stores such as Gama, SOGO and Giant. His strategic leadership ensures that each brand aligns with market demands while maintaining its unique identity and customer appeal.

### Legacy and leadership

His career journey—from law to retail—leverages on an ability to adapt, innovate, and drive business success. His keen interest of market dynamics, customer preferences, and operational efficiencies continues to shape the future of the retail industry in Malaysia, and beyond.


